
UPN for 2020: Moving Forward in the New Normal

UPN In The Community and Aviation Camp Update

With the government lifting many restrictions, the 2020 Youth Aviation Summer Camp, with Youth Taking Flight is now officially a go! Promotion and planning for the camp unfortunately was delayed significantly due to the current situation. We had hoped to send the information out months

ago but had only received the green light from our government partners earlier this month. This is not ideal but we are grateful to be able to make it happen. That being said, camp starts Monday July 20th and runs to Friday August 14th. Youth Taking Flight has already registered close to 80%! Due to the new normal, we are reducing the number of young people participating this year from 30 youth to about 16 youth. Also, many of our field trips have been cancelled due to the current pandemic. So a modified program will be put into effect to respect government regulations and health concerns, and at the same time allow us to deliver a great program for our young campers. UPN volunteering will be limited due to social distancing restrictions and government regulations for youth camps in Ontario.
